Health & Safety Guidelines



General Measures

Requirements for Everyone

- Use of Masks (masks with filters are prohibited at SCS)
- Maintain Social Distancing
- Frequent Hand washing
- Stay home when sick

Students should bring a personal hygiene kit to school daily which includes:

- Water bottle
- Hand Sanitizer
- Antibacterial Wipes
- Kleenex
- Extra face masks



Health Protocols

When to stay home:

- Any student or staff who has **TESTED POSITIVE** for COVID-19, and/or has had **SYMPTOMS** consistent with COVID-19 illness (fever, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, new loss of sense of smell and/or taste) should isolate at home.
- Any student or staff who is known to have had **EXPOSURE** (*defined as close contact within 6 ft for more than 15 minutes*) to anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 14 days should self-quarantine at home.

QUARANTINE FOR EXPOSURE: 10 days have passed since exposure to COVID-19 positive person and has had no development of symptoms.



Health Protocols

Notification of illness/exposure:

- Parents are responsible to **notify the Health Office** if their child has been exposed to, and/or developed symptoms/tested positive for COVID-19.
- **Health Office will be responsible for contact tracing and notification of parents** for any student who has had potential exposure and needs to quarantine.

Return to school policy:

- At least 24 hours have passed since recovery defined as resolution of fever **without** the use of fever-reducing medications; **AND**
- **A minimum of 1 negative SARS-CoV-2 RT-PCR test result** has been obtained.



Health Screenings

Arrival Process

- Student entry through **playground gate only**
- **Remain in your car** until screening completed
- **Windows down and masks on** upon arrival
- Temperature check, screening questions
 - Recheck if needed (located near playground)





Classes & Schedules





ES Hybrid Overview

- Classes will be divided into two subgroups for each homeroom teacher.
- Students will be placed in groups based upon teacher recommendation, association with siblings in other grade levels/divisions, and other factors.
- K-4 students will attend their homeroom classes four days per week (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday) in either an AM or PM session.
- PreK students will only attend in the morning.
- Students opting to stay online will join their group via Zoom. Live teaching will be streamed synchronously via Zoom.



ES Hybrid Details

- **Class Schedules**
 - English-language academic instruction (ELA, Math, Science, Bible) will be taught in-person during the AM or PM on-campus session.
 - Spanish and Sociales will be taught online in the AM or PM session that is opposite of the students' on-campus instruction.
 - Specials classes (Art, Music, PE, SEL) will be taught online on Wednesdays - no change.



ES Hybrid Details

- Daily Schedule
 - AM groups
 - Arrival time: 7:15-7:45am
 - Instructional time: 7:45-10:15am
 - Dismissal time: 10:15-10:45am
 - PM groups
 - Arrival time: 11:45am-12:15pm
 - Instructional time: 12:15-2:45pm
 - Dismissal time: 2:45-3:15pm
- PK through grade 2 will be grouped by section and escorted to class at 7:45am.
- Grades 3 and 4 will go directly to their classrooms upon arrival.



ES Hybrid Details

- Logistics
 - Simultaneous learning for in-person and those opting to stay home in the distance learning model
 - Goal is to maximize English-language instruction while in person
 - Associate teachers will assist with managing student movement to the restroom
 - Students will bring own water bottles
 - Students will be distanced in the classrooms
 - Students will only interact with the students in their classroom
 - Students will not share materials
